Are you friendly, reliable, and enjoy connecting with local businesses? We are looking for **Community Volunteers** to help grow and manage our network of collection tins in the local community.

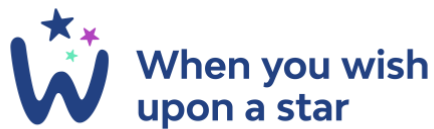
